


Our venerable father Theodore the Sykiot in the neighborhood of Sykeon in Galatia, bishop and hegumen. Seized by a love of solitude from childhood, he chose an austere sort of life. Having reluctantly been consecrated bishop of Anastasiopolis, he begged the Patriarch of Constantinople for a long time that he might return to his former retreat. (c. 613)

Immediately after the opening blessing, "Christ is risen..." is sung once by the priest and then twice by the faithful.


Troparion of the Previous Sunday – The holy apotle Thomas – *Tone 7*

Alleluia - *Tone* 8 (Psalm 94:1,3):




Verse: Come, let us sing joyfully to the Lord; let us acclaim God our Savior.

Instead of "It is truly proper . . ."


