

## THIRD HOUR PROPER FOR APRIL 28<sup>TH</sup>, 2020


### <sup>1</sup>Tuesday in the Third Week of Pascha

**The holy apostles Jason and Sosipater**, disciples of St. Paul in the reign of emperor Nero. They are mentioned in Romans 16:21 by Paul, who calls them his kinsmen. Jason was first bishop of Tarsus, and Sosipater, of Iconium. **The holy martyrs Dadas, Maximus, and Quintillian**, at Dorostorus in Moesia, martyrs in the persecution of the emperor Diocletian. (c. 4th century)

**Our holy father Cyril, bishop of Turau.** Born to wealthy parents, he received an excellent education and decided as a young man to dedicate his life to God. Entering a monastery, he soon became a spiritual father. He tried to become a solitary, but his fame spread. When the bishop of Turau died, he was elected bishop in 1169. He was zealous for his people and a famous and effective preacher. (c.1182)






**Theotokion of Third Hour - Tone 3:**
