


THIRD HOUR PROPER FOR MAY 19TH, 2020

Patrick replied, "If he wills, he can keep me whole and uninjured, although I would wish, in this water, to be parted from this temporal life that I may live eternally with Christ; but let his holy will be done, without which not a hair of a man's head can fall." and broke the cowardly val - or of de - mons. Through his prayers, O Christ our




God, save our souls.
