

Troparion of the Resurrection - *Tone 2*




When you de - scended to death, O Im - mor - tal Life, you de - stroyed

and broke the cowardly val - or of de - mons. Through his prayers, O Christ our



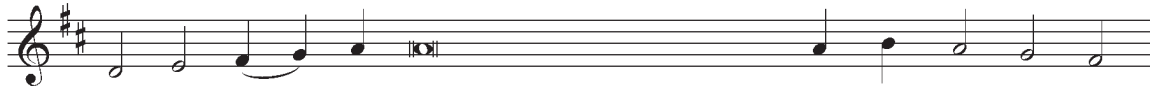
God, save our souls.

where - fore, we im - plore you, O La - dy, to in - ter - cede



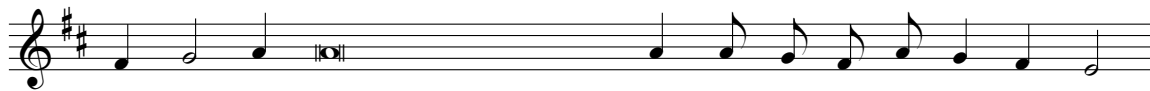

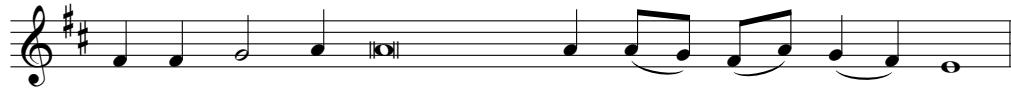
Kontakion - Tone 2
