




Her passing is kept on Sept. 16; today is the day that her holy relics confirmed the orthodox faith at the Fourth Ecumenical Council in Chalcedon (451)













Prokeimenon - *Tone 4* (Psalm 67:36,27):




Verse: In the churches bless God; from Israel's wellsprings bless the Lord.
