

## DIVINE LITURGY PROPERS FOR JULY 15<sup>TH</sup> Saint Stephen Byzantine Catholic Church








## **Prokeimenon -** *Tone* 8 (Psalm 18:5,2):




Verse: The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament proclaims his handiwork.
