


THIRD HOUR PROPER FOR NOVEMBER 15TH, 2020

TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST


¹The holy martyrs and confessors **Gurias, Samonas, and Habib**. Gurias, ascetic, and Samonas suffered at Edessa in Osrhoene. They were condemned to death under Diocletian the emperor by the prefect Mysian after lengthy and savage torture and then were beheaded by the sword. Habib was a deacon who suffered for the faith later. (322) **Here begins the forty-day fast before the feast of the Nativity of Christ.**

Troparion of the Resurrection - Tone 7




You have de-destroyed Death by your cross; you o-pened par-a-dise to the thief.






Theotokion of Third Hour – Tone 5:
