
## TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



Then his hands and feet and head were pierced with nails and he consummated his martyrdom. Our venerable father Acacius, mentioned in "The Ladder" was a novice living under an evil Elder. Through all of the abuse the Elder gave, Acacius was patiently trusting that the Lord would bring good out of evil. He died an early death and testified from the


grave against the elder, who repented.
