



FIRST & THIRD HOUR PROPERs FOR OCTOBER 23RD, 2022

TWENTIETH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

1  **The holy apostle James, the brother of God**, called the Just One, was the first to rule the Church in Jerusalem. Paul testifies that he was among the witnesses of the Resurrection (cf I Cor. 15:7). When a controversy about circumcision arose, he dissented from the opinion of Peter, that the old yoke not be imposed on the gentiles. Not long afterwards, he crowned his apostolate with martyrdom.


