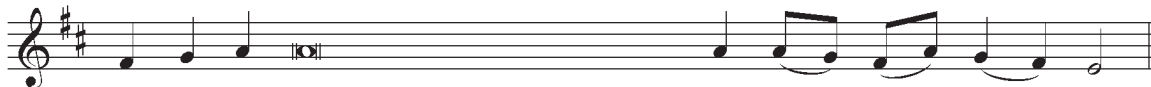

Now and ev - er and for - ev - er. A - men.

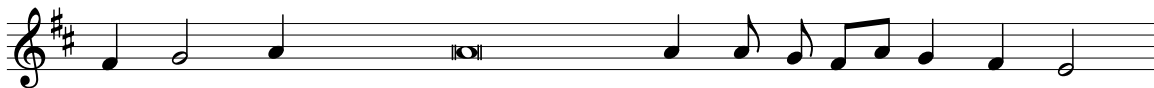
Theotokion of First Hour - *Tone 2*:

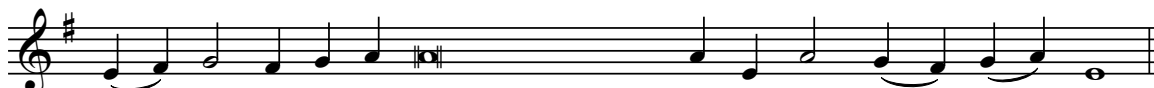

of the prod-i - gal son: I have sinned a - gainst you, O mer-ci - ful Fa - ther;

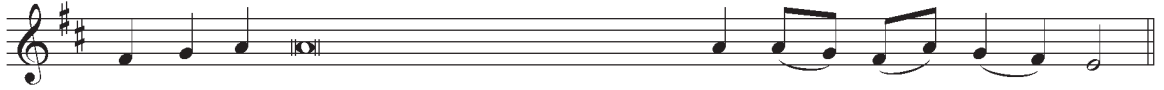
