#### This Sunday's Hymns and Proper's - Tone 6

The minimum proper's (required changeable parts) for Tone 6 are found on Pages 152–153 of the teal pew book. Per the approved *Typicon*, a prescribed Marian Kontakion—called a Theotokion—may be added. Each tone has its own approved Theotokion, and it is traditionally included when the proper's are not complex, such as on many Sundays after Pentecost. For Tones 5–7, the appointed Theotokion is "Steadfast Protectress," Tone 6 (Page 426). Therefore, for today we sing:

- Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone 6 top of Page 152
- Glory..., Tone 6 top of Page 153 (or follow the cantor; exclude *Now and Ever*)
- Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone 6 bottom of Page 152
- Now and Ever..., Tone 6 near the top of Page 153 (or follow the cantor)
- Theotokion, Tone 6 ("Steadfast Protectress") top of Page 426
- Prokeimenon, Tone 6 middle of Page 153., Alleluia, Tone 6 bottom of Page 153
- Communion Hymn For Sunday (Psalm 148:1) Page 78

**Note:** Some Byzantine Catholic parishes, including Sacred Heart, observe certain minor liturgical adjustments during the period of preparation for the Nativity of Christ, beginning after the Feast of St. Philip (November 14). This period is commonly known as Philip's Fast. Any such changes will be announced individually by the cantor.
